Which cookies do we use?

We use cookie technology for our website to help us provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and allow us to improve our site. Cookies are small text files that are sent from our web server to your browser as part of your visit to our website and are held on your computer, tablet or smartphone for later retrieval if you agree.

We use the following cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website.
- Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enable us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them below:

Our cookies:

• [__ASP.NET_Sessionid] This cookie facilitates system functionality and is used to identify a user's session on our servers.

Third-party cookies:

Please note that third parties (including, for example, providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies such as:

- [__ai_user] This cookie is part of Microsoft Application Insights and is used for the statistical evaluation of user behaviour on our websites. The cookie stores a unique identifier to recognise users on returning visits over time.
- [__ai_session] This cookie is part of Microsoft Application Insights and is used to preserve users states across page requests.
- [__gid] This cookie is part of Google Universal Analytics and is used for the statistical evaluation of user behaviour on our websites. Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.





- [__gat] This cookie is part of Google Universal Analytics and is used for the statistical evaluation of user behaviour on our websites. Used by Google Universal Analytics to throttle request rate.
- [__ga] This cookie is part of Google Universal Analytics and is used for the statistical evaluation of user behaviour on our websites. Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.
- [__cfduid] This cookie is used by the content network, Cloudflare, to identify trusted web traffic.

Additional cookies can be set by third-party providers via their plugins. Information about these cookies can be found in the privacy statements of the respective third-party providers.

Disabling cookies

In your browser you may disable cookies altogether, restrict them to certain websites, or configure your browser to automatically notify you when a cookie is about to be placed and ask for your feedback. You can block or delete individual cookies. For technical reasons however, this may result in some features of our website being impaired and no longer functioning completely.
